*All biopsies and excisions will have the procedure fee, as well as the tissue exam by a pathologist either at a Vanguard lab or an outside lab (depending on your insurance). The tissue exam may require additional testing so can be >\$200.

**Mohs surgery removes skin cancer; additional reconstructive surgery is required to repair the defect.

For self-pay patients, there is approximately a 13% discount for seeing a Physician Assistant or Nurse Practitioner, instead of a physician for most codes.
