Job Summary:

Full-time position available in a state-of-the-art facility, located within a federally qualified Rural Health Center in Southeast Arkansas. In the late 1980's, following an extensive community needs assessment, it quickly became apparent that rural Southeast Arkansas was in dire need for access to health care services. St. Elizabeth's Health Rural Health Center was established in 1990, followed 2 years later by DePaul Rural Health Center, 10 miles away in Dumas, AR. The Dental Clinic was established in 2002, in response to a long-standing community need. The Dental Clinic, located within St. Elizabeth's Health Center, focuses on restoring and maintaining dental health for families. Services provided through the Dental Health Clinic include: -urgent care -routine cleanings -fillings -extractions -sealants -x-rays -fluoride treatments – and patient education. The dental services are provided by a Dentist and Registered Dental Hygienist, supported by a Dental Assistant and Dental Receptionist.

Package

Daughters of Charity Services of Arkansas offers a competitive salary and full benefits which include Healthcare Benefits (Medical, Dental, Vision and Life) – Associate pays 20% of premiums; fully paid malpractice; 403/B Employer Automatic Contribution (based on years of service, salary, etc.); HRA of \$1200 if employed on December 31; Flexible Spending Account; Paid Time Off (accumulates at 9.23 per 80 hours); Up to \$2,000.00 provided annually, may be used for continuing education, professional membership fees and DEA Registration; additionally, the Clinic is a certified NHSC site and dentists meeting eligibility guidelines are encouraged to apply for the NHSC student loan forgiveness program.

Facility

The Daughters of Charity Services of Arkansas (DCSARK), was established in 1990 in response to a community needs assessment that revealed communities, in the Southeast Delta area of Arkansas, had a severe lack of access to healthcare services. DCSARK, a member of Ascension Health, the largest Catholic not-for-profit healthcare system in the country, was created to respond to this dire need for healthcare services. The Dental Health Clinic, located within St. Elizabeth's Health Center, is an essential part of the comprehensive network of services provided for the population served by DCSARK. The Dental Clinic serves all persons with special attention to those who are poor and vulnerable. The Clinic offers services to self-pay patients using a sliding fee scale.
