

Medication to stop taking 1-2 weeks prior to surgery per your physician:

Any Anti-Inflammatory medication:

Ibuprofen	Clinoril
Advil	Arthrotec

Daypro	Relafen
Naprosyn	Indocin
Aleve	Mobic

- Any multiple vitamins that contains E or K

- Herbal drugs
- Glucosamine
- Ginseng
- Garlic
- Ginko
- Ginger

*Tylenol is okay to take**

-Can continue to take regular prescription medications, but check with your physician and call with any questions or concerns.

****It is also important if you are taking lovenox, Coumadin, warfarin, enoxaparin. Arista Xarelto, Plavix or any other anticoagulant to notify us and the prescriber to coordinate care. Stop any ACE inhibitor or ARB at least 24 hours prior. (Meds ending in -pril or -sartan).**
